- 4. I have thought about Warren King's case a lot since my jury service. I believe that some people are so evil that they deserve the death penalty. But there are people who do far worse things than Mr. King did, and get much lighter sentences.
- 5. I do not believe that it is fair that Walter Smith got a life sentence, when Warren King got a death sentence.
- 6. I know that Mr. King was present at the convenience store, but to this day, even after hearing the evidence at trial, I do not know who pulled the trigger.
- 7. I do not believe that Warren King deserves the death penalty. I would support a sentence of life or life without parole for him.
- 8. After the trial, I have never spoken with anyone representing Mr. King until now. Further affiant sayeth naught.
